November 19, 2023

Call to order @ 10:35 AM

Started with a prayer initiated by President Mike Hagerty

Old Business:

- -Motion to approve minutes by Jim from September 2023, all in favor, motion carried.
- -No update on accompaniment- could potentially get recorded organ music with a fix to our current organ
- -Get the video from Mitch Kezar on the website- Dave will talk to Mitch about it
- -Africa fundraiser went well. +\$3,000 was raised need to make contact with Peggy
- -Dave and Hal + electrician talking about new lights
- -Dave fixed steps and cleaned the carpets
- -Jim talked to both Green Wealth and Hal Becker about separating cemetery funds and the entire checking account. All have decided to not separate accounts. At year end, we will assess what can be put into the perpetual care fund.

New Business:

- -5 year plan input from Meg: fundraising efforts suggestions:
- -Silent and live auctions
- -Rummage/yard sale
- -Craft show/sale
- -lce cream social
- -Website with a donate button? GIVE BUTTER (Laura's suggestion-post meeting)
- -5 year plan needs to be edited, will do in December
- -Is there interest in donating extra clothes to Liberia?
- -Year end gifts: Will talk about it next month
- -Delano sesquicentennial 2026- Is there someone from our church that wants to be a part of the planning committee for the city?

Financial Report:

- -Checking account saw an increase since September
- -Potentially another library cost coming
- -Utilities are higher than last year
- -Green Wealth is down again
- -Missions: our church's wider mission (an expense), we budget for \$1000, but we have already given \$1,500. \$1,045 designated for OGHS, plus extra funds available for other missions. Jim will talk to Geralyn about the Liberian wells.
- -Must decide about our year end donations.

Dave motioned to accept, all in favor, motion carried.

Appreciating Advent





We go though this "Advent time" every year. Kids appreciate an Advent Calendar. It's fun to look for the next day, open the little door, and take out a little item like a toy car or a piece of candy. In a few homes there might also be a conversation about Advent as a waiting time. The disciples spread the word that although, Jesus died soon on the cross, he had risen. He was with us then and is with us now, and someday will come to judge the people.

That's probably too much for children who are waiting for Santa Claus to be at the mall. These kids also might have an Elf on a Shelf to help them with their waiting. Very few of them will have a nativity set where they can see the angels gathering around and the baby Jesus will finally be born. It sounds extra special that he's wrapped in swaddling cloth and laid in a manger.

It's not just children who have trouble waiting. In our church I have struggled to keep Advent as an important part of the church year. A special time rather than a mini Christmas. 


